

Phase 1: Start

TRIGGER CRITERIA FOR RETURN TO PHASE 1:

- State/Local shutdown reinstated
- OR
- Negative trend in regional COVID-19 data* over a rolling 14 day tracking period:
- OR
- Negative trend in HAFB COVID data** (lower threshold than regional data)

Phase 2A: Cautious

TRIGGER CRITERIA:

- State/Local gaiting criteria met
- AND
- State Public Health indicators show a positive trend in six categories which is sustained for 10 days beyond the relevant component of the MA phased reopening plan* (or by exception with justification)
- AND
- Positive 14 day trend in HAFB COVID-19 data**

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR PHASE 2A EXECUTION

- Plans coordinate w/ mission partners
- All units using Standard Mitigation Precautions
 - Sufficient base support capability for cleaning supplies and PPE
- Public Health Augmentee Plan

Phase 2B: Vigilant

TRIGGER CRITERIA:

- 45 days in Phase 2A with no upward trend in the monitored MA* and HAFB** metrics
- AND
- Satisfy gaiting criteria for MA and Middlesex Country or justified deviations

* Regional COVID-19 Data of Interest

- MA COVID-19 Positive Test Rate
- MA Number of State Deaths
- MA Number of Patients in Hospitals
- MA Healthcare System Readiness
- MA Testing Capacity
- MA Contact Tracing Capabilities

** HAFB Data of Interest

- Positive results of testing at 66 MDS & living/working on Base
- Quarantined individuals of close-contacts
- Middlesex/Suffolk county data

Phase 3: New Normal

TRIGGER CRITERIA

- COVID-19 vaccine developed and administered to 90% of AD population at Hanscom AFB

Phase Transitions

Installation commander provides at least a 10 day notice

Transitions between phases can go in both directions
